





#### FONTS

Together, Big Caslon, Josefin Sans, and PT Serif provide an elegant, modern feel that create a visual hierarchy useful for organizing titles and body copy clearly.

#### COLORS

The colors are traditional Christmas colors that see more infrequent use in modern-day holiday imagery. They are darkened and blended to convey elegance and modernity.

#### TEXTURES

The textures come from linen cloth and felt paper, providing a classic, refined, and elegant feel while adding depth.

#### TYPE OF IMAGERY

Natural photography featuring wintery images made up of mostly cool colors (blue, indigo, violet, green—but mainly blue). Warm colors can be present in parts of the photos but never make up the majority of a design's imagery. When the required imagery falls outside of these guidelines, a blue tint can be added, or the photo can be used on the opposite side of the piece.



### FRAME VARIATIONS

## SCROLL = ADVENT



The corners suggest the shape of a scroll unraveling, alluding to the old world Christian symbol that represents the coming of the Prince of Peace. This scroll border will be used on all of the main *Season of Advent* artwork that is not focused on a specific word (Hope, Peace, Love, Joy), and it will be paired with blue.








#### FRAME VARIATIONS

# ANCHOR = HOPE



The corners suggest the shape of an anchor, alluding to the old world Christian symbol that represents hope. This anchor border will be used on all of the artwork that is focused on Hope, and it will be paired with green.






The corners suggest the shape of a dove, alluding to the old world Christian symbol that represents peace. This dove border will be used on all of the artwork that is focused on Peace, and it will be paired with purple.



#### FRAME VARIATIONS

# HEART = LOVE




The corners suggest the shape of a heart, alluding to the timeless symbol that represents love. This heart border will be used on all of the artwork that is focused on Love, and it will be paired with burgundy.





SYMBOL = JOY



The corners include the old world symbol that represents joy, while also suggesting the shape of a candle and a flame for advent. This symbolic border will be used on all of the artwork that is focused on Joy, and it will be paired with Red.
